IMPORTANT EXPLANATIONS IN RELATION TO DATA SUBJECT APPLICATION FORM AND THE RIGHT TO APPLY:

1.Data Subject's Right to Apply

Article 11 of the Personal Data Protection Law numbered 6698 sets forth that data subject may make requests in relation to the following matters.

- to learn whether personal data are processed
- if personal data are processed, to request information as to the processing
- to learn the purposes for which the personal data are processed and whether such data are used in accordance with these purposes
- to be informed of the third parties, within the country or abroad, to whom personal data are transferred
- if personal data are processed incompletely or inaccurately, to request the rectification thereof

• in case the bases requiring the processing of personal data cease to exist even though personal data were processed in line with the Personal Data Protection Law and other relevant provisions of law, to request the deletion or destruction of personal data and to request that this be notified to third parties to which personal data have been transferred

• to request that the actions taken for correction, erasure, destruction or anonymization of personal data be notified to third parties, to which personal data have been transferred

• to object to any results to the detriment of the data subject reached by analysis of personal data exclusively through automated means

• to request compensation for any damages incurred due to the unlawful processing of personal data

2. Exemptions to the Right to Apply

As per article 28 of the PDP Law, it is not possible for data subject to assert their rights in relation to the following:

• personal data are processed for official statistics for purposes such as research, planning and statistics provided that they are anonymized

• personal data are processed for artistic, historical, literary or scientific purposes, or within the scope of freedom of expression provided that national defense, national security, public security, public order, economic security, right of privacy or personal rights are not violated or the processing doesn't constitute a crime

• personal data are processed within the scope of preventive, protective and intelligence activities carried out by public institutions and organizations duly authorized and appointed by law to maintain national defense, national security, public security, public order or economic security

• personal data are processed by judicial authorities or enforcement authorities with regard to investigation, prosecution, judicial or enforcement proceedings

As per article 28/2 of the PDP Law, in case of the following, it is not possible for data subjects to assert their rights other than the right to request compensation of damage.

• processing of personal data is necessary for the prevention of committing a crime or for the investigation of a crime

• processing of personal data is carried out on data which are made public by the data subject itself

• processing of personal data is necessary for the performance of supervisory or regulatory duties and disciplinary investigation and prosecution to be carried out by the appointed and authorized public institutions and organizations and by professional organizations qualifying as public institutions, in accordance with the power conferred on them by the law

• processing of personal data is necessary for the protection of economic and financial interests of the State in terms of budget, tax and financial matters

3. Data Subject's Right to Lodge a Complaint with the Personal Data Protection Board

Pursuant to article 14 of the Personal Data Protection Law numbered 6698, if the application is refused, the response is found insufficient or the application is not responded to within the specified time period, the data subject may lodge a complaint with the PDP Board within thirty days from the data subject receiving the response of Orjin and, in any case, within sixty days as of the application date.
